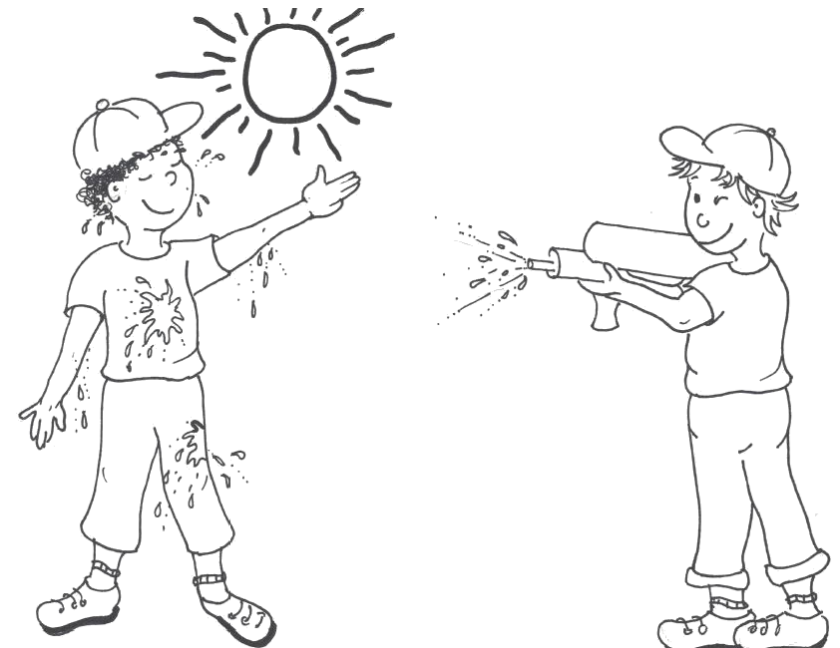

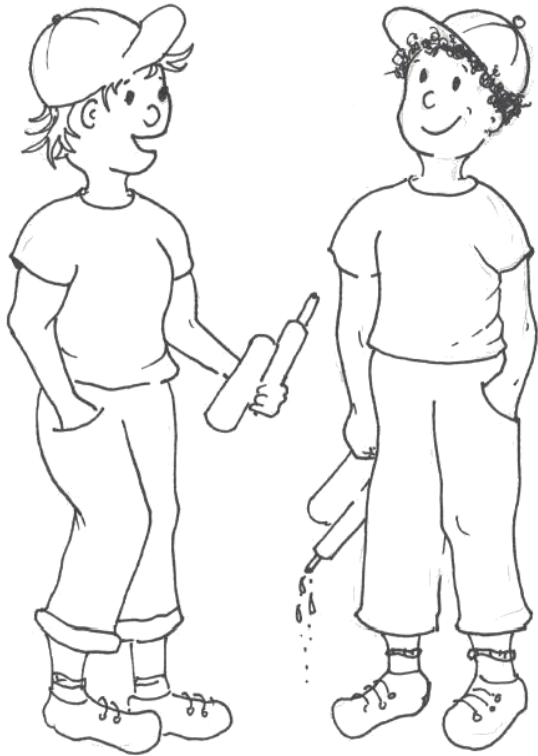

“Look,” said Sam to Gus.

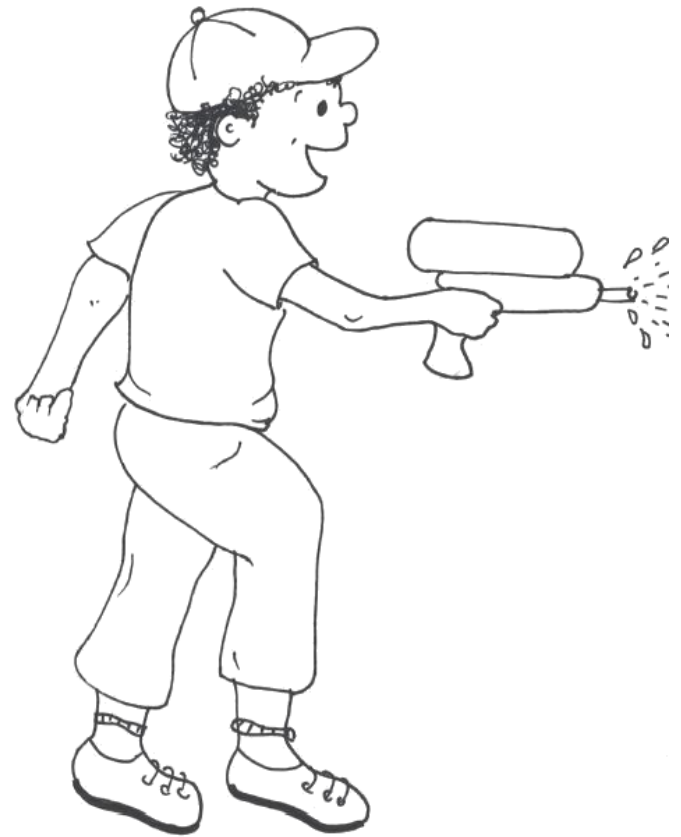
“I have a gun.
