Exposing children to the natural manner of learning English is done via songs, word games, chants and dialogues. Abundant research and years of working in the field have demonstrated that when children are exposed to verbal English in a conversational manner, they will soon be able to carry out simple commands and understand basic sentence structure, which will strengthen future reading and writing skills.

This seminar will focus on introducing the teacher to hands on techniques that she can apply either in small group settings or the classroom to lead the beginning learner from basic vocabulary to more complicated spontaneous dialogue within a school year.

Upon completion of this course, the teacher will:

- A. be familiar with the curriculum, its structure and function
- B. know how to develop drill games
- C. have learned songs/chants and when and where to use them
- D. know how to develop dialogues and build on them to achieve basic conversation
- E. know how to develop games that can be used with a few players or teams
