Let's go on a plane.



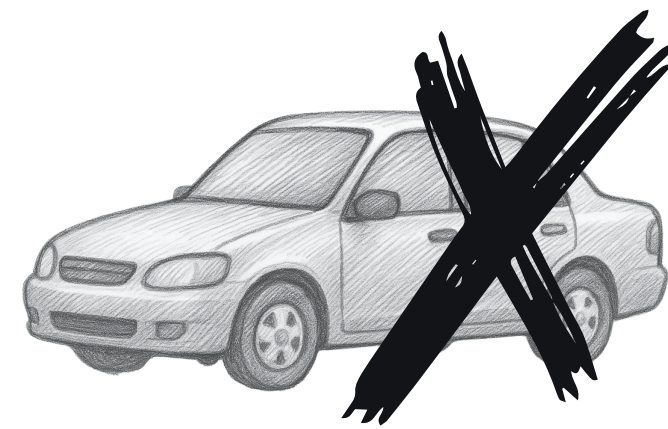
Not on a bus.

Not in a truck.



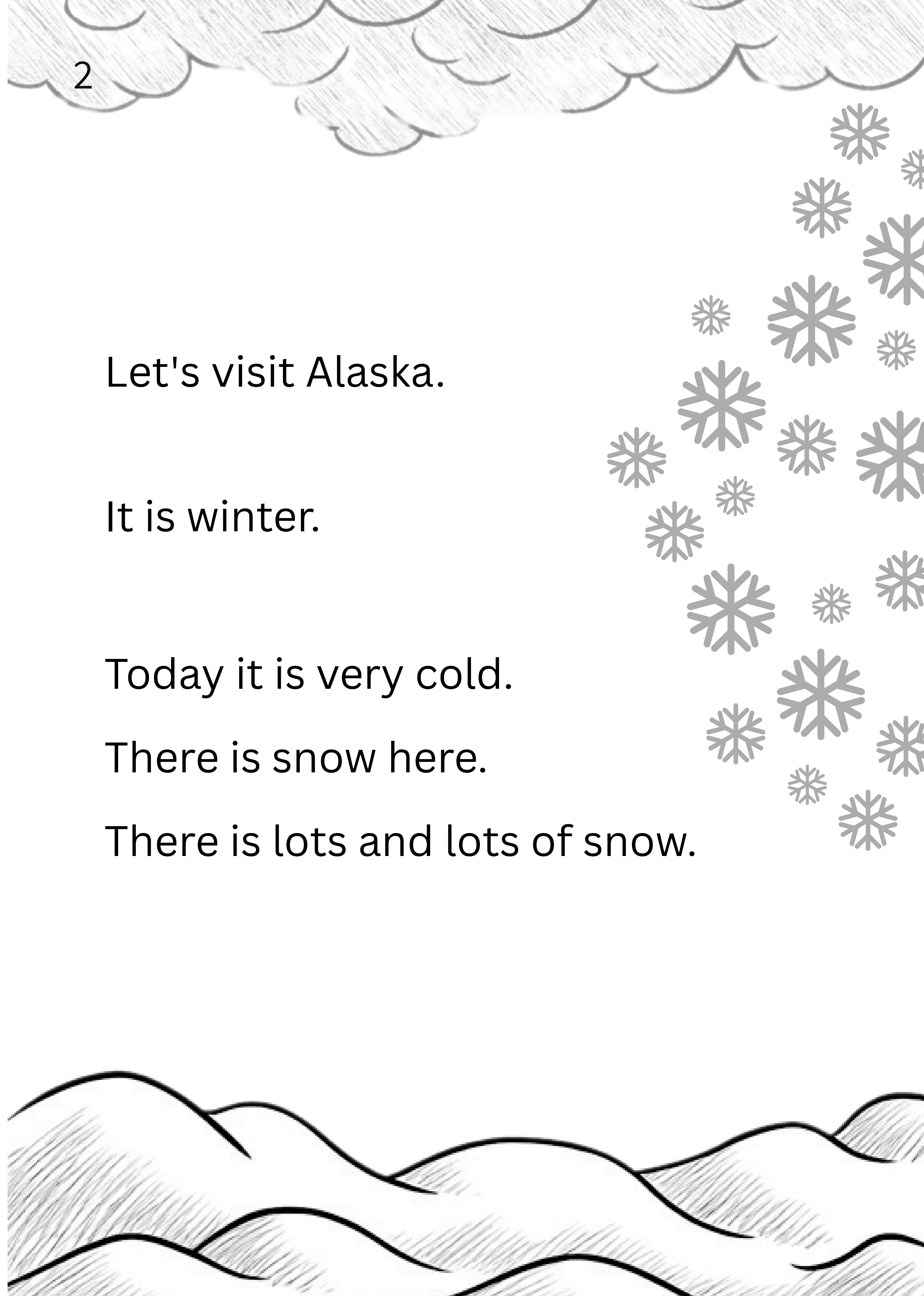
Let's visit Alaska.

There is lots and lots of snow.





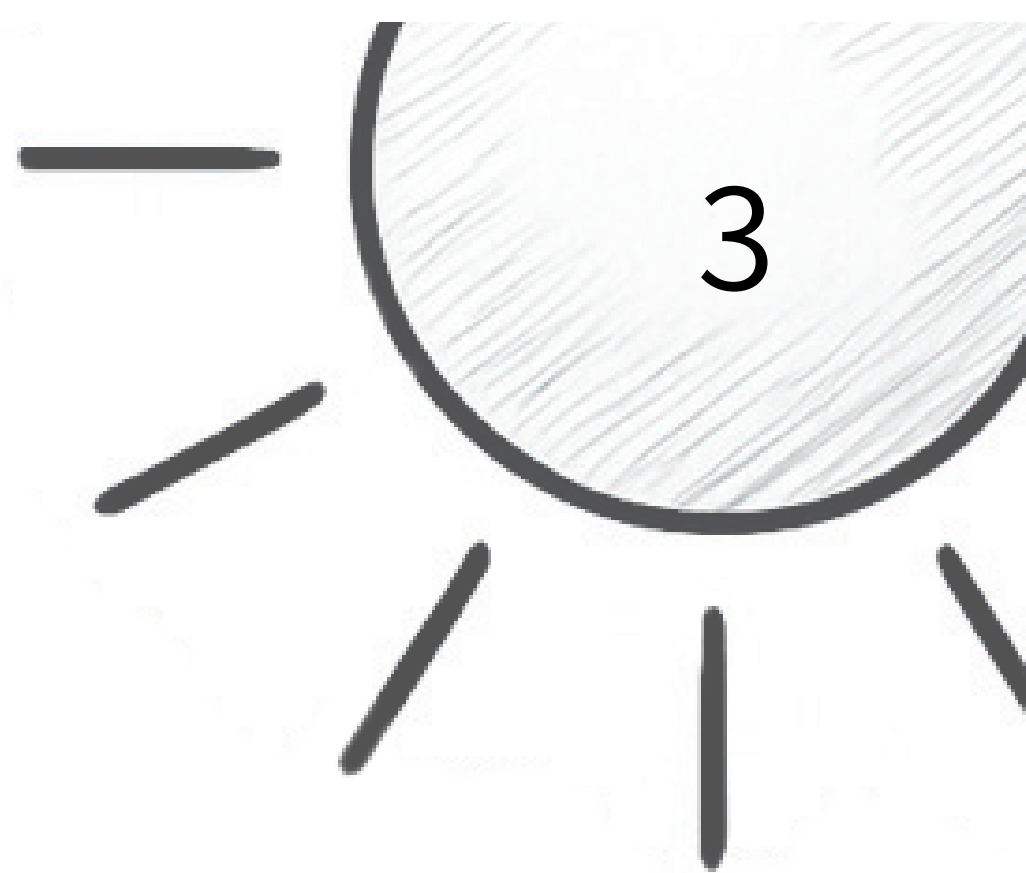
Let's visit Mexico.

There are leaves on the ground.



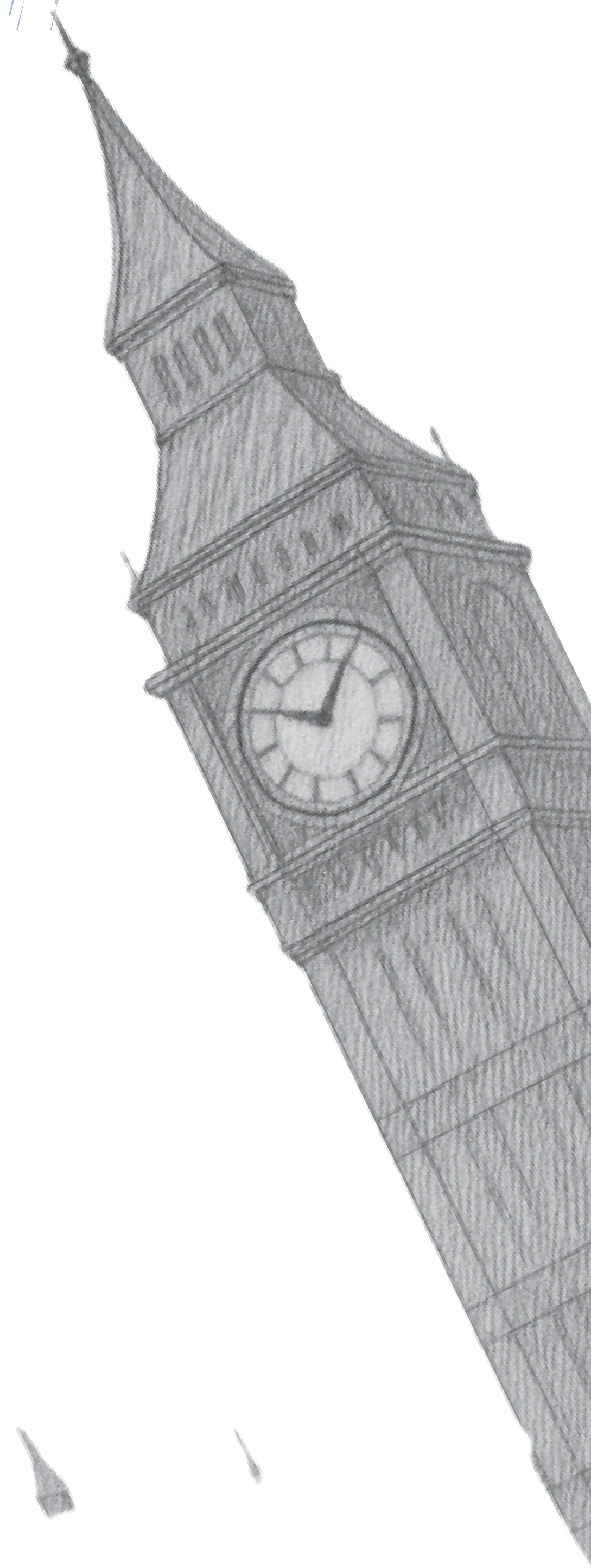
Let's visit England.

Today there is rain.

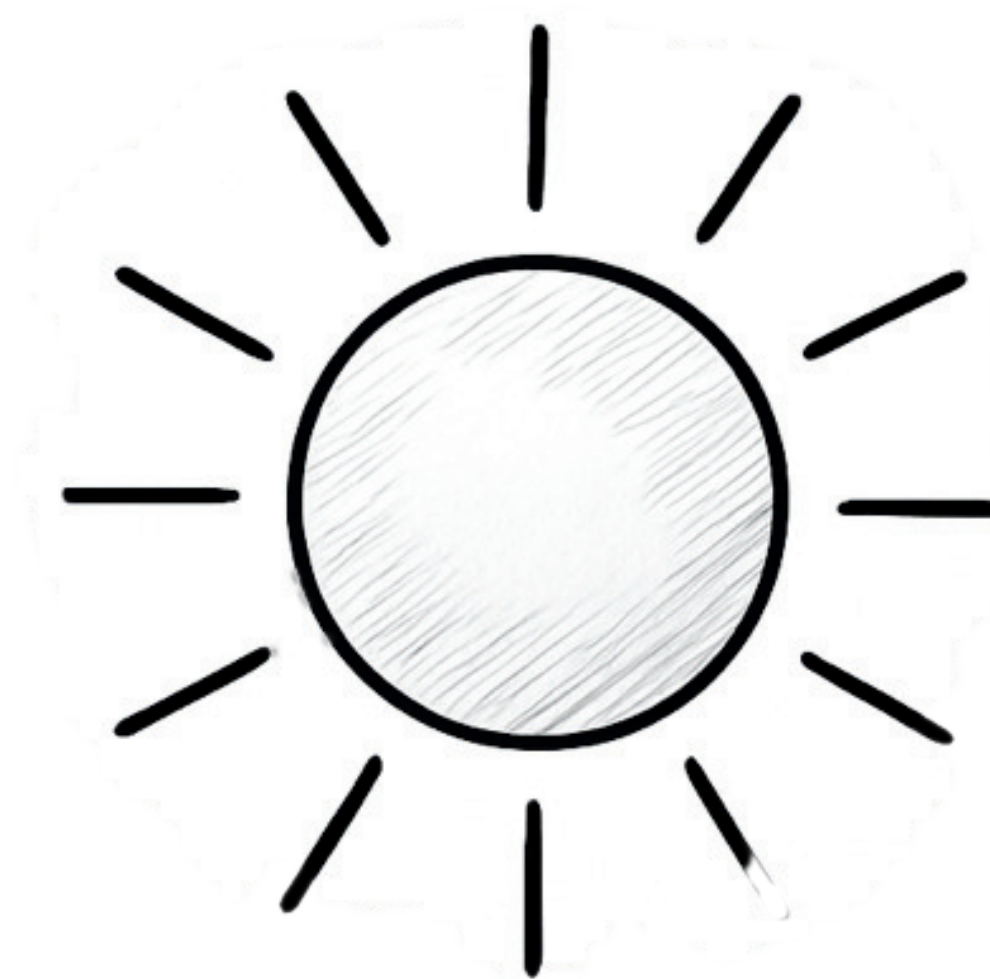
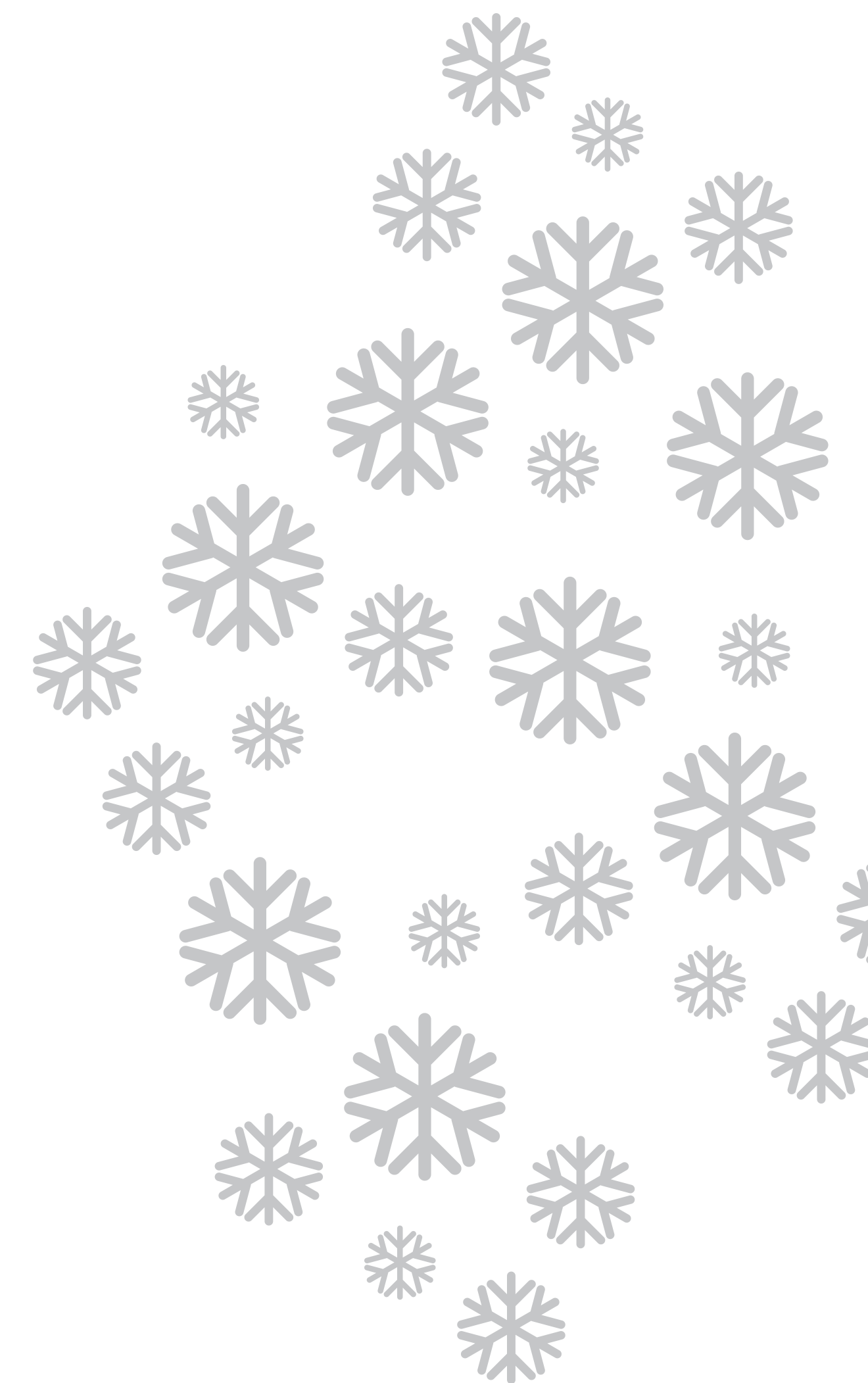
There are many flowers.

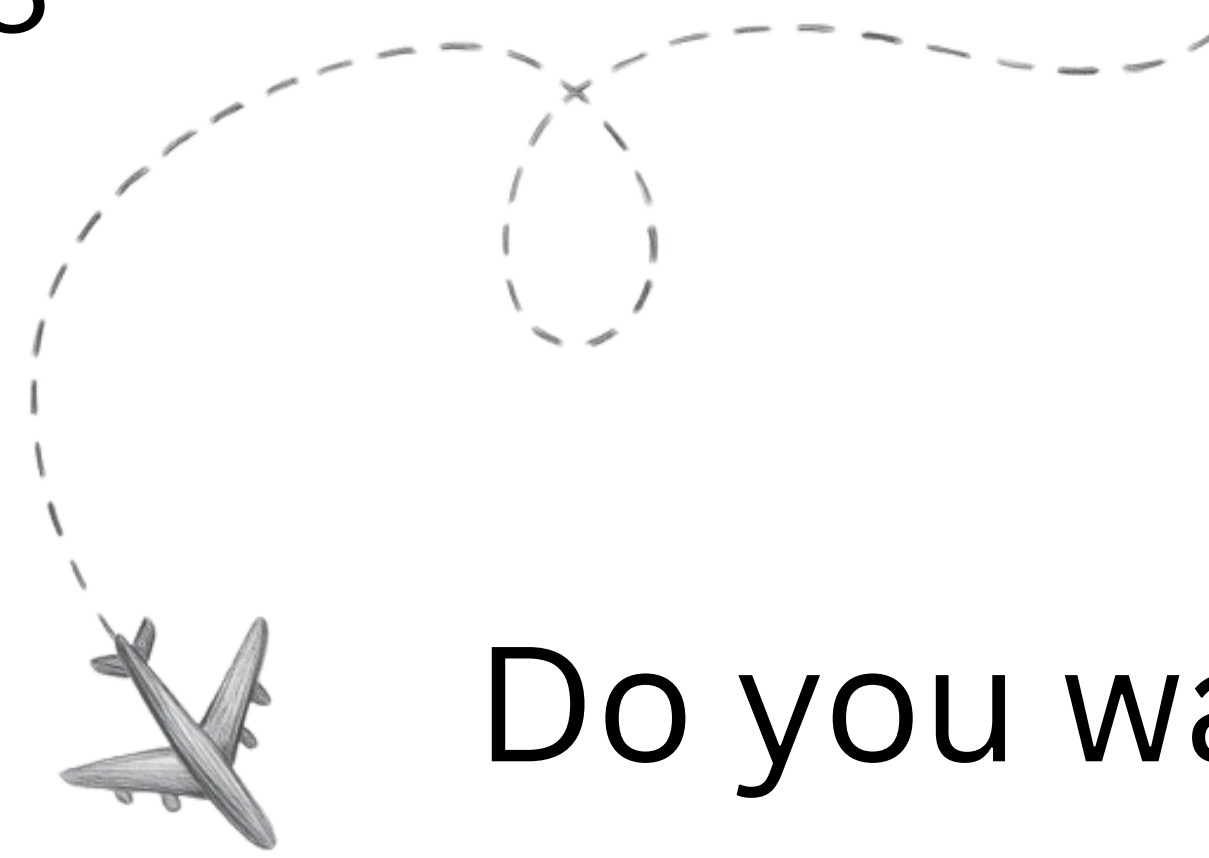

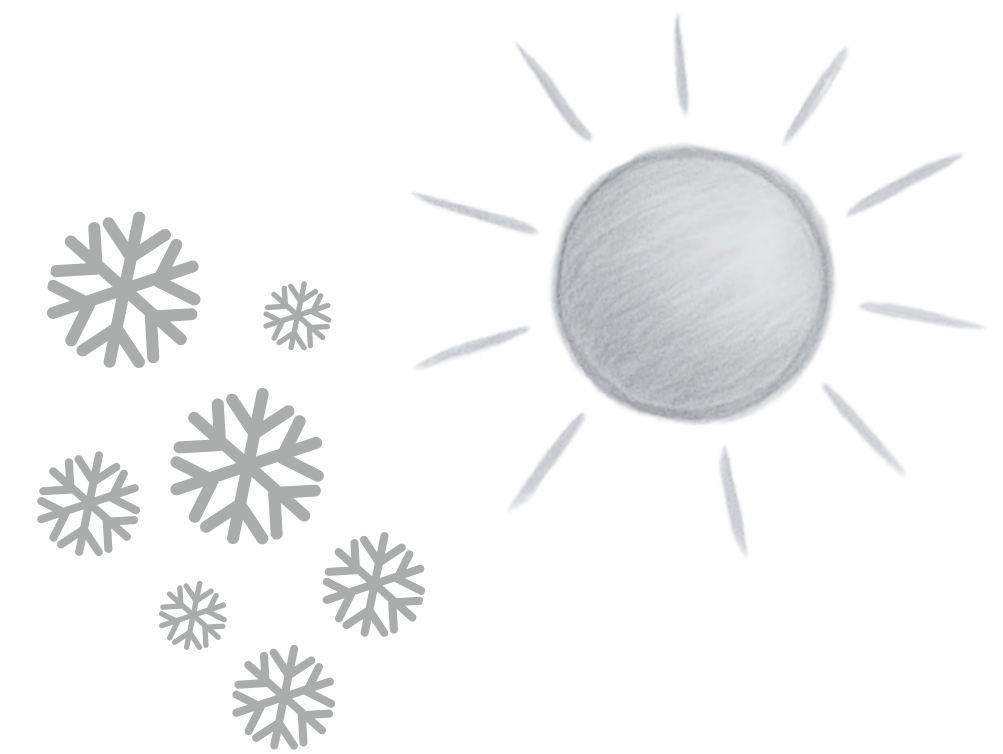
