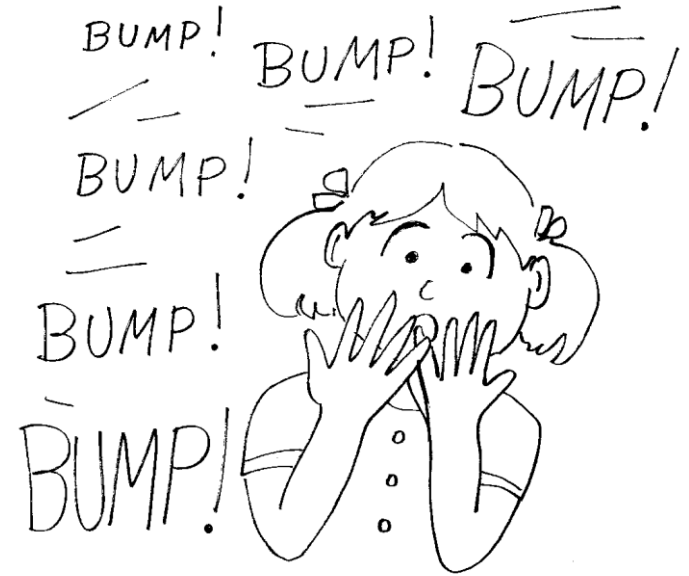
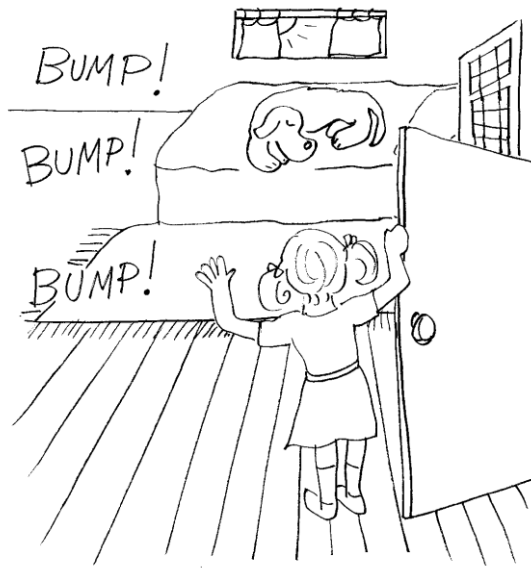
Bump. Bump.

Oh, I hear a bump.

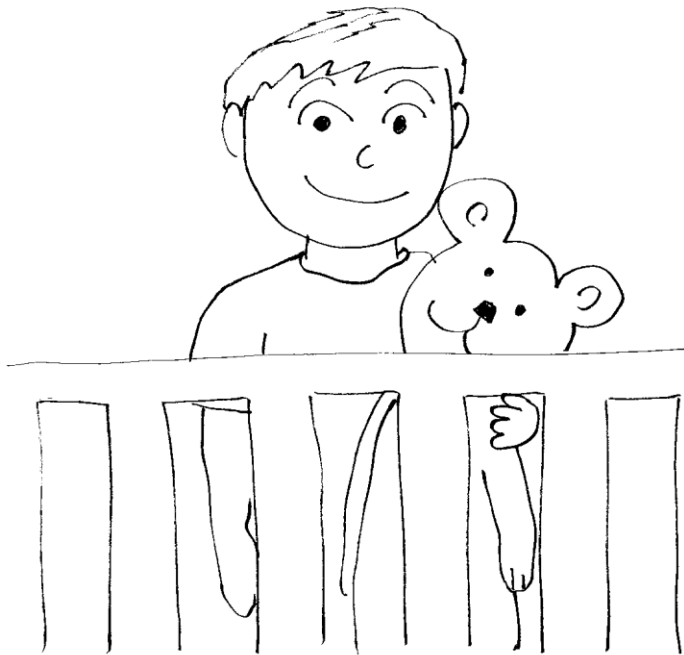
The bump is near.

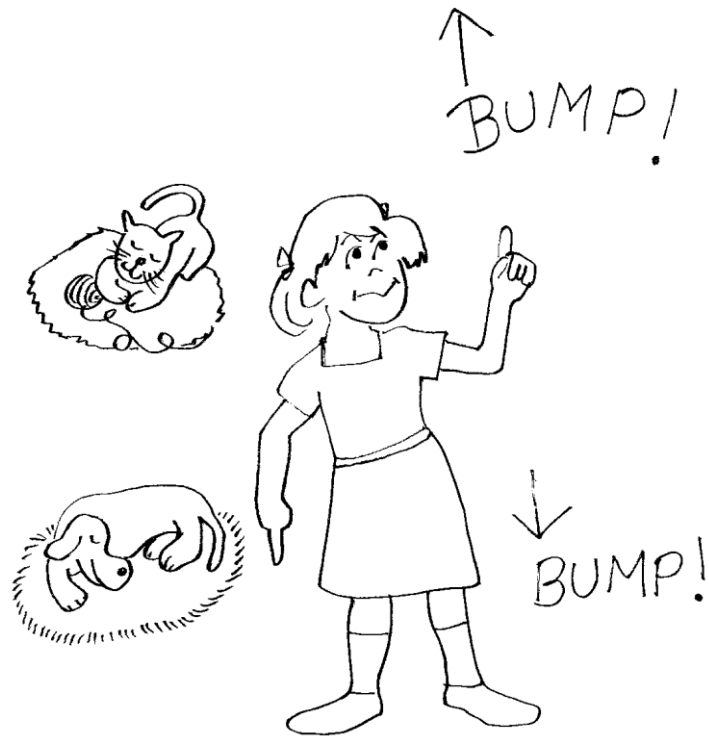
The bump I hear is poor Fred's doll.
